

Voice for the Child in the Womb Who Cannot Speak!

On Sunday October 7th from 2:00 to 3:30 PM, the Pro Life supporters of Somerset County will again participate in the National Pro Life Chain

Life Chains are the coming together of people of all ages and denominations in their local communities to give prayerful, peaceful witness to the sanctity of life, from conception to natural death. Life Chain is a means to counter our culture's disordered values and point our community to God's love and mercy for all human life. With your help, we can build a devout prayer vigil that God can use to change hearts and save lives and families.

Life Chain began 30 years ago in California. Since 1987, this life affirming witness has grown across the U.S. and Canada with over 1,600 cities and towns holding Life Chains in 2016. Life Chain offers us the opportunity to take a mere 90 minutes to pray and witness for the protection of the Child in the Womb.

The National Right to Life Committee calculates that over 59 million babies have been killed by abortion since the 1973 Supreme Court Roe v. Wade decision. While you may never know, your presence at Life Chain could result in an expectant mother who is thinking of abortion, to reconsider and say "Yes" to life for her child.

We silently hold signs proclaiming the sacredness of all human life and seek God's protection for the child in the womb, and forgiveness for the sin of abortion. Life Chain is a time for prayerful self-analysis, repentance, and serious commitment to helping end abortion in our nation.

Mary Mother of God's parishioners should stand along Somerset Street, anywhere from the corner of Route 206 down to Veteran's Memorial Hwy. The Life Chain then continues up Mountain Avenue past Immaculate Conception Church.

Thank you for participating in this year's Life Chain and being the "Voice for the Child in the Womb Who Cannot Speak", the most innocent and least among us. We all need to add our prayers and voices to the defense of all human life.
